CASE STUDY

Exceptional service during exceptional circumstances

CWT stands ready to do whatever it takes to ensure continuity of high-quality service for clients in face of emergency—not only for affected areas, but for multinational operations which require ongoing support.

For example, as Hurricane Ike approached the Texas coast, CWT evacuated some of its *Energy Services Group* team to a remote location to continue 24/7 operations. As a result, even as the entire city of Houston was evacuated and shut down, clients experienced no service disruption and 98 percent of calls were answered in fewer than 30 seconds.

During the 2008 hurricane season which included Eduardo, Ike, Fay and Gustav, *CWT ESG* evacuated 10,000-plus personnel from the Gulf of Mexico, finding alternative housing or transporting them home.
